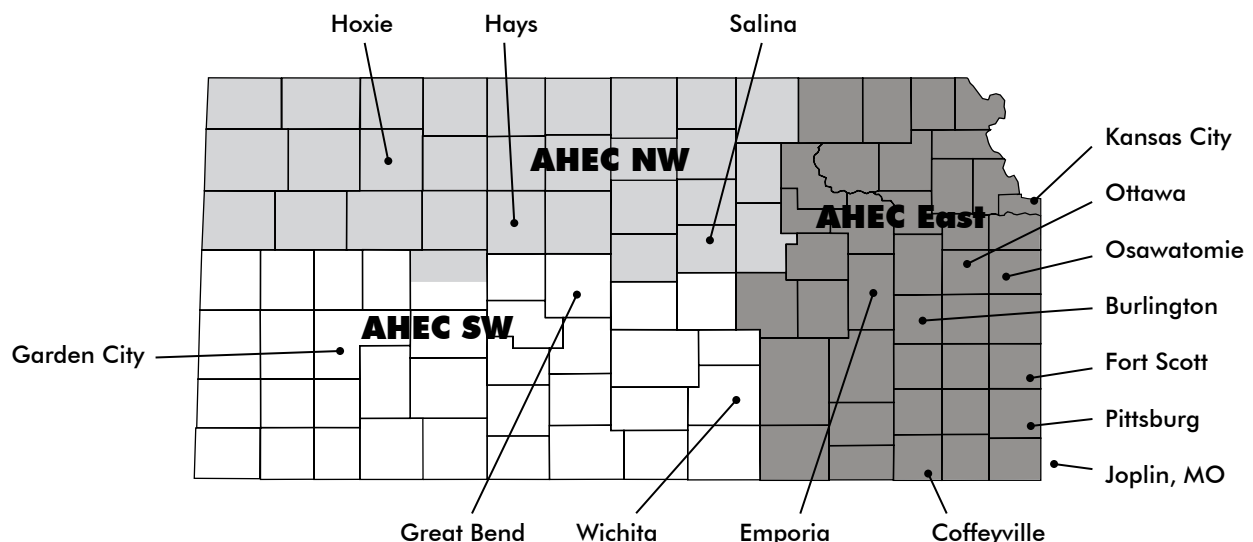

3. **Online** - online credit card registrations are not available at this time.
