FREE! ONLINE CNE PROGRAM ON PEDIATRIC OBESITY

As a service to Kansas and Missouri school nurses, the University of Kansas Clinical Child Psychology Program is pleased to offer a free, online, self-paced CNE program on pediatric obesity. School nurses can receive 4.8 CNE credits upon completion.

What is Elluminate?

What is Elluminate and how does it work? Elluminate is a webcast system utilizing only your computer. Elluminate allows you to view continuing education programs from the convenience of your home or other location of your choice. With Elluminate, you hear the speaker's voice and view Powerpoint slides if they are used. In addition, you can respond and ask questions by typing in a chat box on the Elluminate screen in which the moderator will then address.

Here you will learn more about Elluminate and determine if you have the required software to run Elluminate *Live!*

With Elluminate, programs are recorded and then made available to you at a later date as an Independent Study. When registering for Elluminate, you will receive additional information and a link at that time.

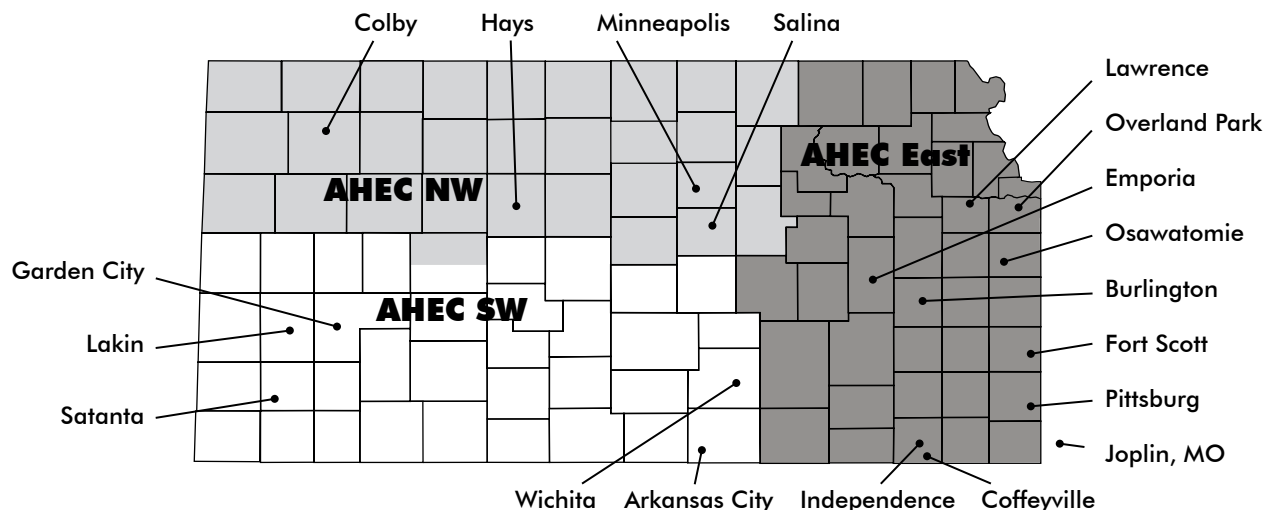

CONTINUING EDUCATION AHEC POLICIES

In order to be able to provide quality continuing education programs at an affordable price, the University of Kansas Medical Center Area Health Education Centers have the following policies.

■ **Registration Policies:**

1. **By mail** - the registration form must be completed and accompanied by check, money order or credit card (MasterCard or Visa) for the correct amount made payable to the appropriate AHEC.
2. **By telephone** - registrations will only be accepted over the phone with a credit card guarantee (MasterCard or VISA) or Purchase Order Number. Participants will not be considered registered/enrolled for a program unless the appropriate fee has been paid prior to the offerings' preregistration date.
3. **Online** - online credit card registrations are not available at this time.

■ **Additional Policies:**

1. A late fee of \$10.00 will be assessed if the registration is received after the announced preregistration date, or if the payment is made at the door. Registrations at the door will be accepted only if space is available. Preregistration is your only guarantee of space and handout material.
2. **Cancellation policy:** A registrant may cancel within the cancellation deadline for that program to receive a refund, minus a \$15.00 administrative fee. After that time, no refunds are made. The registration fee will not be transferred to future offerings. Refunds are made by mail.
